STATEMENT

Pursuant to notice, a hearing was held in Gary, Indiana, on August 14, 1961.

THE ISSUE


The grievance reads:

"Aggrieved employee, R. Rosado, #5751, contends that on April 15, 1960, he was indiscriminately demoted from Bridge Operator in the Coal Handling sequence. The aggrieved was given a training period of twenty-two (22) days on this occupation where other employees have been given as much as 5 or 6 weeks. The training that Rosado received was not a reasonable training period.

Request that the aggrieved employee be given a longer training period so that he can learn the functions of this occupation the same as everyone else."

DISCUSSION AND DECISION

The Union withdrew this grievance at the hearing.
