STATEMENT

Pursuant to notice, a hearing was held in Gary, Indiana, on November 21, 1961.

THE ISSUE

The grievance reads:

"Aggrieved employee, B. Handley, #23663, lost one (1) day of work September 18, 1960, because Management had a four (4) day a week schedule posted and did not notify him of a change to a 5-2 schedule which was posted on a Friday, September 17.

Aggrieved employee, B. Handley, requests one (1) day's pay. September 18, 1960, as Mould Yard Craneman.

DISCUSSION AND DECISION

The principles enunciated in Award No. 460 are equally controlling in this case. Mr. Hanley's testimony that on September 1 he gave Foreman Wilder his correct new address was not refuted by direct Company testimony.

AWARD

The grievance is sustained. The employee shall be made whole for earnings lost.
