The Acting Company Step 4 Representative and the Union Step 4 Representatives reviewed their respective positions as outlined in the Step 3 and Step 4 minutes.

The Union Step 4 Representatives noted that the grievant had not had the benefit of advance notification of the consequences of refusing the drug screening test since the notice concerning the mandatory nature of such testing was not posted at the 80" Hot Strip Department. Moreover, the Union Step 4 Representatives noted that the patient assessment given the grievant prior to the decision to test him for drugs was not conclusive as to symptoms of possible drug usage.

The Acting Company Step 4 Representative conceded the above points raised by the Union Step 4 Representatives. In view of the above mentioned facts, as well as all of the other attendant circumstances in this case, the Acting Company Step 4 Representative offered to partially grant the subject grievance by reinstating the grievant to his former position in the 80" Hot Strip Department, making the grievant whole for all monies lost, less the balance of the turn on September 15, 1988 and one additional working turn, which would serve as discipline for the grievant's admitted reporting to work under the influence of alcohol.
